Sub: National Health Mission - Tamil Nadu –Placement of 2448 Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) /Health Inspector Grade II in Health Sub Centres/Health and Wellness Centres on Contract basis through District Health Society under NHM-TN – Instructions for the recruitment by strictly adhering to the prescribed criteria as per Government Orders– Reg.

The Universal Health Coverage (UHC) program is being implemented in Tamil Nadu since 2017 and has been recently integrated with the State's flagship '**Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam**' scheme. Achieving UHC is a priority for the State and this requires fully functional Health and Wellness Centers (HWCs) that meet the standards set by the Government of India, one which includes the placing of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) / Health Inspector Grade II at Health Sub-Centre level HWCs.

In this regard, the Government has issued orders (**Annexure I and II**) for the placement of **2448 Multipurpose Health Worker (Male)/Health Inspector Grade II** in Health Sub Centre level HWCs on **contract basis** through the District Health Society.

The **total vacancy** of Multipurpose Health Worker/Health Inspector Grade II in your District and HUD is given below:

The District and HUD wise list of HWCs where MLHPs are to be placed is provided in **Annexure-III**.

In continuation to this, the Government has issued clear and detailed guidelines (**Annexure I**) to adopt the same modality for the **selection of contractual Multipurpose Health Worker (Male)/Health Inspector Grade II in HWCs as prescribed in the selection of contractual Mid-Level Health Providers (Annexure II)** in HSC-HWCs under NHM-TN. The terms of reference for the selection of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male)/Health Inspector Grade II are attached in **Annexure IV**.

You are requested to ensure uniform and transparent recruitment of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male)/Health Inspector Grade II at the District level.

The following key guidelines are to be adhered without exceptions:

- It is informed that the Multipurpose Health Worker(Male) /Health Inspector Grade II post is on a **contractual basis** and **purely temporary** in nature which should explicitly stated in the advertisement and the appointment letter issued to the selected candidates. A self-attested declaration (**Annexure V**) for the same should be signed by each of the selected candidate and submitted to the respective DDHS through Block Medical Officer(BMO)
- The selection of Candidates will be based on the prescribed Qualification & Eligibility criteria along with the **weightage-based scoring (Annexure-IV)**
- An open advertisement will be made centrally by NHM-TN in at least two newspapers and one of which would be in Tamil and subsequently a detailed advertisement should be posted on the District's website by the Chairman, District Health Society. (A format for the advertisement is attached in **Annexure VI**)
- The timeline for the Multipurpose Health Worker (Male)/Health Inspector Grade II selection process given below:

ORDER:

During the Assembly Session 2021 - 22, the Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following announcement in the Floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly (Announcement No. 16):-

“கிராமப்புற சுகாதார சேவையை மேம்படுத்த புதிதாக 2400 செவிலியர்கள் மற்றும் 2448 சுகாதார ஆய்வாளர்கள் ரூபாய் 17.42 கோடி செலவில் நியமனம் செய்யப்படுவார்கள்”.

2. In Government Order 1st read above among others the Government have sanctioned 7047 posts of Health Inspectors (Multi Purpose Health Supervisor-2486/ Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) 4561) for implementation of Multipurpose Health Worker scheme in Tamil Nadu.

3. In Government Order 2nd read above, among others, the Government have issued further continuance for 31,331 temporary post attached to the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine for the period of 3 years upto 30.06.2006.

4. In Government Order 3rd read above, among others, the Government have permitted the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine to appoint 742 Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) trained candidates as Health Inspector Grade-II.

5. In Government Order 4th read above, among others, the Government have revised the norms for Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) (Health Inspector Grade-II)

and Multipurpose Health Supervisor (Health Inspector Grade-I). In Government Order 5th and 6th read above, the Government have issued orders for the implementation of Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam scheme in Tamil Nadu.

6. Now, the Mission Director, National Health Mission in his letter 7th read above has stated that, World Health Organization has declared COVID-19 epidemic affecting many countries including India as Public Health emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) and has also characterized it as pandemic, which require urgent massive efforts for control. Considering the present situation arising due to COVID -19 Pandemic in the country, Government have decided to prescribe regulations to prevent the Outbreak of Corona Virus diseases COVID-19 under the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 (Central Act No. 3 of 1897). The post of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) / Health Inspector Grade-II is the very important posts in this current content of COVID 19 and their role is very much required to prevent and monitor the spread of COVID-19 and other communicable diseases. Due to insufficient posts of Health Inspector available at present, the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine faced challenges to control the spread of COVID-19, dengue, Swine flu and Non-communicable diseases.

7. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has further stated that, as per the operational guidelines of Government of India for AYUSHMAN BHARAT Comprehensive Primary Health Care through Health and Wellness Centers, the key inputs to be provided at a Health and Wellness Centres under the Primary health care team to deliver the expanded range of services at the Health Sub Centres - Health and Wellness Centre includes a Multi-Purpose Health Worker (Male) also. As the State aims towards the achievement of 'Health for All' by the implementation of Universal Health Coverage through Health and Wellness Centres in the State as well the Hon'ble Chief Minister flagship "**Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam scheme**, which provides holistic and comprehensive set of "**Home Based Health Care Services**" to the community, the role of an Multi-Purpose Health Worker (Male) is very significant. In order to meet the changing health needs of the community the Multi-Purpose Health Worker (Male) [MPHW (M)] plays a vital role in preventive and promotive health care in the primary health care delivery system. He has also stated that, engaging services of Multi-Purpose Health Worker (Male) [MPHW (M)] in Health and Wellness - Health Sub Centres in addition to Mid-Level Healthcare Providers benefits the community and the primary health care team and also strengthens the "**Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam scheme**."

8. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has further stated that, the sanctioned strength of Health Inspector Grade I is 1806 and Health Inspector Grade II is 1641 and necessary proposal for sanction of Multi-Purpose Health Worker (Male) [MPHW (M)] or Health Inspector Grade-II was proposed in the PIP 2021-22 and the same was approved by the Govt. of India in ROP 2021-22 under FMR 8.1.13.22. The 41st Executive Committee Meeting of the National Health Mission - Tamil Nadu has approved the above proposal in principle and the committee has also instructed that detailed selection and eligibility criteria had to be developed for recruitment process. Moreover, the Executive Sub Committee in circulation note no.15 /2021, dated 18.08.2021 has approved the selection criteria, Rationalisation, Qualification and Eligibility for these posts as follows and requested to issue necessary orders:-

i. Selection Criteria:

A competitive exam at District level through District Health Society could be conducted containing both essay pattern and MCQ type. (25 marks for Essay +25 MCQ (1 mark each)) for 50 marks eligibility with the prescribed qualifications could be considered as the selection criteria by following the 200 rosters (communal rotation).

The transparency and quality of the exam will be audited concomitantly by Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and National Health Mission, Tamil Nadu. The question paper will be prepared at the state level and exam mode will be online.

ii. Rationalisation:

Further, it is submitted that these posts are temporary and contract basis (through District Health Society) would be rationalized by considering the in-position of Multi-Purpose Health Worker (male) in other parallel program/scheme and regular postings to ensure that not more than one Multi-Purpose Health Worker (male) is engaged in per Health and Wellness Centre, Health Sub Centre.

iii. Qualification and Eligibility:

9. The Government have examined the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission in detail. As per the existing rules and regulations in force, Medical Services Recruitment Board is the recruiting agency for selection of para medical post in Health and Family Welfare department, duly following the communal rotation, not district health society. The Government therefore issue the following orders:-

- the Mission Director, National Health Mission is permitted to place 2448 Multipurpose Health Workers (Male) / Health Inspector Grade II in Health Sub Centres - Health and Wellness Centres as detailed below:-

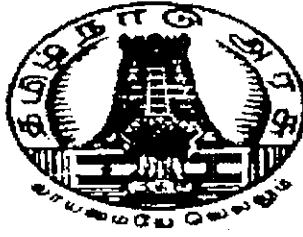

ORDER:

In Government Order first read above among others, the Government have permitted the Mission Director, National Health Mission to implement the Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam scheme in Tamil Nadu through the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in coordination with the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and the Director of Medical Education.

2. In Government Order second and third read above among others, the Government have permitted the Mission Director, National Health Mission and the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine to place Staff Nurses with GNM/B.Sc., Nursing qualifications in all 4848 Health and Wellness Centres as Mid-Level Health Care Providers on contract basis through the District Health Society.

3. Now, the Mission Director, National Health Mission in his letter fourth read above has stated that, the early recruitment of Mid-Level Healthcare Providers is crucial for the functionality of Health and Wellness Centre to meet the Government of India targets. Furthermore, the placing of Mid-Level Healthcare Providers in all Health and Wellness Centre across the State is also important for the successful upscaling and sustainability of the Hon'ble Chief Minister's “Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam” flagship scheme. He has furnished the guidelines with a detailed scoring sheet to assess application for selection of contractual Mid-Level Healthcare Provider posts to Health and Wellness Centres for approval of the Government.

4. The Government after careful examination have decided to approve the terms of reference with scoring criteria to assess the applications for the selection of contractual Mid-Level Healthcare Provider post to the Health and Wellness Centres as annexed to this Government Order.

**The Terms of Reference for the selection of Mid-Level Health Care Providers
(MLHPs) in Health and Wellness Centres on contract basis under the “Makkalai
Thedi Maruthuvam Scheme”**

I.	<u>Details of the Post</u>	:	Mid-Level Health Care Providers post is on Contractual basis and purely temporary in nature. The Personnel to be recruited under NHM will be a contractual employee of the society and not the Government. The contractual service will not be regularised on any account and there would be no grounds for permanent absorption.
II.	<u>Details of Remuneration</u>	:	Rs. 14,000 /- per month as per NHM norms. Any future revision to the pay by NHM will be automatically applicable.
III.	<u>Recruitment Policy</u>	:	a. Applications shall be invited by the Chairman, District Health Society (District Collector). b. The number of vacancies advertised is only an indicative number and is liable to change, subject to the actual requirement. c. The mandatory members of the Selection Committee will be as follows: i. District Collector as Chairman ii. Project Director, DRDA iii. Joint Director Health Services iv. Deputy Director Health Services v. Project Officer, ICDS d. The decision of the Chairman of the District Health Society is final in the selection process. e. The selection of MLHPs is purely on Contract basis through an open advertisement which will be made centrally by National Health Mission in at least two Newspapers and one of which would be in the vernacular language. f. The detailed advertisement with the relevant particulars will be subsequently posted in the District website and also in the website of NHM -Tamil Nadu. g. During the selection of the candidates, weightage-based scoring will be given based on various criteria. A detailed scoring sheet is attached in the annexure II to this order and is to be used to objectively evaluate applications on a one-to-one basis. h. Female Nurses will be the candidate of choice for the post of MLHP since the HWCs aim to provide Comprehensive Primary Healthcare Services with primary focus on Women Health (Maternal and Child health activities such as care of Antenatal care, postnatal care, screening of cancer Cervix, Breast, Immunization, health check-up referral services) etc., i. Candidates from the same locality / HSC area is given high preference as per scoring sheet since the services of MLHP requires continued and sustained presence in the community for providing uninterrupted community level healthcare services.

			j. Working knowledge of Tamil is mandatory. k. The qualification mentioned for the post should be from a recognized University. l. In case of those who have their Nursing qualifications without the Integrated Curriculum, there will be a mandate to undergo a one-year Certificate Course in Community Health as detailed in Section VII (iii). m. Candidates selected will be requested to submit their original certificates along with other documents as listed in Section VI below. n. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council registration is mandatory for the finally selected candidates. o. Any form of recommendation for selection to the job will summarily result in rejection of selection.
IV.	Age (as on 01.01.2022)	:	Candidates should not be over 50 years of age.
V.	Educational Qualification (as on 01.01.2022)	:	Candidates should possess a Diploma in GNM/B.Sc., (Nursing) from Government or Government approved Private Nursing colleges which are recognised by the Indian Nursing Council.
VI.	<u>List of Documents to be produced by the Candidates at the time of verification</u>	:	Candidates selected will be requested to submit the following original certificates along with one set of self-attested photo copies of the certificates/documents with two recent passport size color photographs (as scanned and sent in the application) i. Evidence of Date of Birth (Birth Certificate/SSLC / HSC Certificate) ii. Evidence of Educational qualification and marks (SSLC / HSC / Diploma / B.Sc., Degree - Provisional or Degree certificate etc.) iii. Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives council registration Certificate iv. Evidence for Tamil eligibility (10th or 12th standard marks) v. Proof of Residency: a. Nativity Certificate issued by the Revenue Department b. Voter ID c. Panchayat/ Municipality/Corporation/Tax receipt d. Aadhar card e. Ration card vi. Certificate of character and conduct issued by a Group A or Group B Officer <u>working in Government. The Certificate should be a recent one issued within 3 months prior to the notification</u> (applicable for all the applicants including fresh graduates) vii. Certificate of character and conduct issued by the Head of the Institution where the candidate had undergone the course or currently studying. viii. In the case of a differently abled person, a Certificate from a Block Medical Officer to the effect that the candidate is fit enough to discharge the duties assigned along with the percentage of Disability. ix. Certified evidence for work experience x. No Objection Certificate from the competent authority (if applicable)

			xi. Any other special records of significance from competent authorities as indicated in the selection criteria mentioned.
VII.	<u>Other Terms and Conditions</u>	:	i) The candidature of MLHP shall not be treated on par with MRB recruited Staff Nurses since they do not come under the Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Services-Branch III-Nursing. ii) The <u>minimum period</u> to be served for this position is 2 years adhering to the contractual norms of National Health Mission – TN (Contract being renewed after completion of every 11 months subject to Performance appraisal) iii) In case of candidates with GNM /BSc Nursing without the Integrated Curriculum qualification, they should mandatorily undergo one-year in-service Certificate Course in Community Health (CCCH) which includes 6 months of internship as per the requirement of Government of India and Government of Tamil Nadu Guidelines iv) In case of selection, the contract appointment will be subject to Medical fitness and verification of character and antecedents. v) Detailed duties and responsibilities and working hours will be charted out by the Mission Director, NHM and Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine separately. vi) The selected candidates will have to join duty immediately or on the date indicated in the offer of appointment. vii) The MLHPs at any time found guilty of any gross misconduct or negligence of her duties shall be terminated by DHS without any notice of payment in lieu of notice period. viii) An absence from work for a period of fifteen days without prior permission of the competent authority will amount to voluntary abandonment of engagement and may result in automatic termination. ix) Once recruited/contracted as an MLHP, prior notice of <u>three months</u> is mandatory for resignation. x) In the event of pre-mature termination of contract for those MLHPs who after placement, underwent the mandatory one-year Community Health Care training, the contract employee will have to comply with any financial obligation as per NHM norms. xi) Declaration Form All the DDHS should receive an 'individual Declaration form' from each of the selected MLHPs to the effect that the candidate is aware that the MLHP post is purely a temporary one on contractual basis, and that services of an MLHP would not be regularized on any account and there would be no scope on any grounds for permanent absorption.

VIII.	Timelines: - 1. Web Advertisement inviting application to be in the prescribed format to be done centrally by O/o NHM Tamil Nadu. 2. Wide publicity to be given by Advertisement which is to be published in the local Tamil and English Daily Newspapers by NHM centrally/NHM Website / District Website/ DPH Website /Nursing council Website. 3. The maximum permissible time to the candidate for submitting the application with necessary documents should be within 14 days from the date of notification. 4. The applications received have to be scrutinized and evaluated based on the scoring sheet in the annexure II to this order within 7 days from the close of applications. 5. The appointment order should be dispatched by the end of the second day of scrutiny. 6. All selected candidates should be instructed to report at the O/o DDHS within 3 days of receiving the orders with the Testimonials and adequate Physical Fitness Certificate issued by an Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon.
